

Spring Semester Canutillo ISD Commitment Form

On January 29, 2021, the Regional School Safety Zones Plan will expire. Any student who wants to attend in-person learning may do so. Any student who wants to continue with remote instruction may continue to do so **unless notified of revocation for non-engagement**. Texas Education Commissioner Michael Morath has instructed districts to notify parents of their two options.

100% Remote Learning at home

● Students will participate in synchronous and asynchronous learning models. This means a mix of and real-time virtual lessons and pre-recorded videos. Grading expectations are the same as the in-person classroom.

Synchronous Learning

- Students are required to attend class on time - per class schedule.
- Students will show their face on the screen to engage with the teacher virtually.
- Students will actively participate in the class.
- **CHS students are required to be in class every day, every period with cameras on.**

Asynchronous Learning

- Complete asynchronous activities assigned each day and **submitted by 11:59 p.m.** for a student to be counted present for attendance.
- Students show proof of DAILY participation by satisfactorily completing assigned assignments to demonstrate evidence of student learning ie. video, picture, or activities and/or completing assignments.
- Students and parents will communicate with the teacher when needing additional assistance, tutoring, etc.

STUDENTS WHO CHOOSE 100% REMOTE LEARNING WILL NOT BE ABLE TO CHANGE TO IN-PERSON UNTIL THE NEXT SURVEY.

100% IN PERSON 5 days a week

● **The district can no longer guarantee class sizes below 15 students.**

● **The hospitalization rate currently stands between 15 -20%.**

● **Parents/guardians are expected to screen their students for COVID-19 symptoms each day prior to sending their student to school. Individuals who present symptoms will be separated and sent home.**

● **CHS continues to have a hybrid schedule.**

● The use of face coverings will be required.

● Desks will be socially distanced as much as possible.

● Student movement will be limited during transitions.

● Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be readily available and thorough hand washing will be practiced.

● Students will be required to eat at campus designated areas. High school students may not leave campus for lunch.

● Students who fail to abide by health protocols will be reassigned to remote learning.

Students who choose in-person learning may change to remote within 2 days of notifying the school.
