Parents' Guide to Student Devices

Set Expectations

Regularly share your expectations with your child about accessing only appropriate sites and content, as well as being a good citizen when online (even when parents aren't watching).

Monitor & Limit Screen Time

Surfing the Internet should be done in a central place at home, such as the kitchen or family room, rather than away from adult supervision or behind a closed door. Know what your child is doing with technology and how his or her time is being spent. Technology can be a great tool and resource, but also has the potential to be a big distractor. Help your child learn to focus on completing tasks or assignments first before spending time on games, browsing, or social networking. Teaching our children how to manage multiple sources of information and potential distractions is a critical life skill, one best learned before heading off to college or the workplace.

Put the device to bed, but not in the bedroom

Parenting experts suggest parking all technology devices, from cell phones to laptops, in a common family room or the kitchen overnight to discourage late night, unmonitored use and sleep disruption. Don't allow your kid to sleep with the iPad, laptop in their room. Remember to model appropriate use and balance of technology in your own life, too!

Cyber Safety

Cyber safety is an important subject to revisit frequently. Children are actually most vulnerable to online dangers while in their own home. The following suggestions are provided to help you guide your child's use of the school device and other technology devices.

Outside of school, parents bear responsibility for the same guidance of Internet use as they exercise with information sources such as television, telephones, radio, movies and other media. Parents are responsible for monitoring their student's use of school-issued equipment, email accounts, and use of the Internet when the student is accessing from home or through other remote location(s).

Filter Access

District-provided student devices filter internet content both at school and at home. We still suggest installing software to filter and block inappropriate content on your wireless home network and non-school devices your children use. Check with your internet service provider to see what content filtering services they may offer.

Consequences

Through this presentation we have learned what we can do to take care of a device loaned to students by CISD

Unfortunately, we have seen that not all of our Canutillo Elementary students and families have been taking good care of the loaned devices and will need to pay for damaged devices.

Next you will find a list of possible damages and costs

Price Sheet provided by CISD technology Department

The technology department will check for accidental coverage, depending on the Apple coverage/not coverage final response

Any iPad with any damage will pay \$100.00

An iPad costs \$402.90 (That's to replace the device. It doesn't include the charger)

Lost/damaged chargers are not replaced by the school.

*We consider a damaged charger if given to the student and used for certain amount of time without any reported malfunctioning.
