



Canutillo Elementary School Safety Protocols

- **Daily schedule: Staggered entry and release**
 - ❖ Pre-K - 2nd Grade 7:30-3:00 school day
 - Arrival: 7:15-7:30 AM Release: 3:00 PM
 - ❖ 3rd -5th Grade 8:00-3:30 school day
 - Arrival: 7:45-8:00 AM Release: 3:30 PM
- **Three available entrances**
 - ❖ Entrance #1 (main entrance)- Pre-K & Kinder, 5th Grade
 - ❖ Entrance #2 (gate by visitors' parking lot)- 1st & 2nd Grade
 - ❖ Entrance #3 (gate by bus loading/unloading)- 3rd & 4th Grade
- No early drop-offs **unless** Canutillo ISD transportation or daycare transportation is utilized.
- Three temperature checks and hand sanitizer stations are available (one per entrance).
- Students will report to classrooms upon arrival through the appropriate entrance or hallway.
- Students will use the same entrance for both arrival (AM) and dismissal (PM).
- Parents should **only** utilize visitor parking lot for drop-off and pickup.
- Parents will not be allowed in the building at any time, unless you have an appointment. You must call the front office to announce your visit.

Parent Expectations

- Students are to be screened by parents/guardians for COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, runny nose, etc.) each day prior to sending them to school
- If your child is sick, your child stays home
- Have a plan in place to pick up your child from school if your child becomes ill
- Sign and follow the CISD Parent Pledge
- Discuss the changes that will be taking place in the school with your child

Student Expectations

- Must wear face covering/mask in classrooms, hallways, common areas and during arrival and dismissal.
- Face shield is optional. A face shield will be provided to PreK-2nd grade students.
- Practice appropriate hygiene and follow campus/classroom procedures
- Students will not share school supplies
- Wash or sanitize hands often
- Practice social distancing
- Students must wear uniforms
- Students must bring their devices daily to school

Teacher Expectations

- Must complete COVID-19 Training Modules and Safety Protocols
- Must wear face covering (mask / face shield) in classrooms, hallways, common areas and during arrival and dismissal
- Required to self-screen daily prior to reporting to work
- If sick, stay home



Canutillo Elementary School Safety Protocols

- Wash or sanitize hands often
- Staff will monitor that students do not share school supplies
- Utilize required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) during classroom procedures
- Staff will monitor social distancing

Physical Education Expectations

- Physical education is a required subject area.
- Class size will be no bigger than 22:1 PE teacher, in different playing areas.
- Teachers will be wearing masks at all times in the presence of others.
- Students must wear proper attire, pants with pockets to store their mask and proper shoes, in case they cannot tie their laces.
- Students will sanitize hands when coming out to PE.
- A 6-10 ft distance will be managed during indoor and outdoor activity based on the intensity of the activity.
- No one is allowed to eat in the cafeteria but the cafeteria is allowed to be used as a PE classroom, with play in small groups.
- Vigorous activity will be limited to outdoor spaces
- Students will take off their mask if the intensity level is high with a 6-10 ft distance.
- Students will fold their mask and place it in their pocket.
- Activities will be focused on limited to no equipment.
- Equipment will be given to one student at a time and disinfected after each use.
- All surfaces that come into contact with students or staff will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- Bring a labeled water bottle to rehydrate.
- Students will sanitize hands when leaving PE.
- Masks will be placed back on prior to entering the school building.

Hand Washing/Sanitizing Expectations

- Staff will be expected to regularly wash or sanitize their hands
- Staff will provide hand sanitizer for students upon entry to classrooms. Teachers will periodically remind the use of hand sanitizer during the instructional day
- All staff and students will practice thorough hand washing after recess, before eating, and following restroom breaks

Expectations for Disinfecting

- Teachers will continue to wear adequate PPE, including face mask and gloves, during disinfecting
- Staff will have access to disinfectant cleaner to sanitize high-touch surfaces (door knobs, tables, handles, desks, chairs, etc.)/shared objects regularly. All cleaning supplies used will be provided by the campus. No personal cleaning supplies or solutions are allowed to be brought to the campus.
- Do not use disinfecting wipes on your hands and/or face

Meals in the Classroom

- Students will eat their meals (breakfast and lunch) in the classroom
- Staff will monitor social distancing in the classrooms



Canutillo Elementary School Safety Protocols

- No delivery of outside food will be permitted such as birthday cupcakes and food for other celebrations. Outside food will only be permitted if it's packed in the student's lunch box.
- Under no circumstances will students be allowed to share food.

Restrooms

- Proper handwashing technique will be consistently reinforced
- Whole class restroom breaks will be implemented to eliminate co-mingling for those who do not have restrooms in the classroom.
- Teacher will monitor social distancing
- If restroom is available in the classroom, it will be utilized
- Restrooms will be disinfected periodically throughout the day
- Water fountains are unavailable, please bring a water bottle daily
