


In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national ongin, religion, sexual orientation, disability, age, marital status, fanily/parental status, income derived from a public assistance program, political beliefs, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity, in any program or incident.
